After a meeting with Sara from the WBOP Council, Shoneen explained that there is now a bye law that our exit doors have to be fitted with a "push bar".

To enable this work to be done the Community Centre will have to close for a week. This work will be paid for by the WBOP Council. The meeting agreed to the closure.

The fire panel, which is connected to the fire brigade, in the old library has been changed from grade 4 to grade 2.

We have acquired some furniture from the old library which may be of use to us.

GENERAL BUSINESS The power and water used during the construction of the library have been sorted.

The Hawkins hut will stay on site until the refurbishment of the old library. It is to be painted, carpeted and a kitchenette to be fitted. Bob will follow up with Chorus re a fibre link – maybe expanders can be used.

Aon will roll our insurance as per the new valuation. The current building sum insured is \$6,373,000 and the revised sum insured is \$6,154,000 – a difference of \$219,000. The hall's plant/contents are insured for \$88.000 replacement value. The invoice will go to Hillary at the council.

What a delight – our new library has been opened. As a committee we are thrilled with how great the new library looks and what a super job has been done to make it such a lovely place for all of our community to use and enjoy
